Please type essays whenever possible.

ALL APPLICATIONS MUST BE POST-MARKED OR EMAILED BY APRIL 15, 2012.

Please note: In compliance with non-profit tax laws, once you or your student(s) are approved for a scholarship, you or your student(s) will need to provide receipts, proof of attendance (if applicable) and any other related documentation along with the Request for Scholarship Payment form before scholarship money can be released to the recipient. You will have until February 15, 2013 to seek reimbursement from NHAEA.

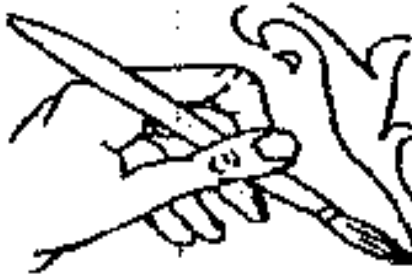

Guidelines for New Hampshire Art Educators' Association Scholarship 2012

The New Hampshire Art Educators' Association Scholarship is available to a student of a current member of the 2011-12 school year. Please be sure to answer all questions on the applications completely, do not leave any question unanswered. **All applications must be post marked or emailed by April 15, 2012.**

Senior Scholarships: Scholarships of **\$500** dollars each are available to **FOUR** graduating high school seniors who will be majoring in art in college in the Fall of 2012. The Senior Scholarships will be based on their artistic ability, their essay and their grades along with the Letter of Recommendation from their current art teacher who ***MUST*** be a current 2011-2012 NHAEA member in order to qualify. An art educator, who is a current member, is allowed submit up to 3 senior applications during this process.

To receive the Senior Scholarship, the student must be enrolled full time in a degree granting institution during for 2012-2013 academic year as a declared art major. The scholarship will be awarded after the conclusion of the 1st semester of the Freshman year. To receive the Senior Scholarship, a grade report for the 1st semester grades showing satisfactory completion (no failing grades) must be sent to the NHAEA Treasurer by February 15, 2013. The grade report does not have to be an official transcript. A printed copy of online grades is sufficient. The \$500 check will be then sent to the recipient.

K-11 Scholarship(s): The K-11 Scholarships totaling **\$250** may be awarded to one student or be divided among several students. The scholarship may be used for art class tuition and/or art supplies needed for that class. Scholarship winners will be required to turn in receipts in order to receive their scholarship money reimbursement *after* the event. The student's nominating art educator ***MUST*** be a current 2011-2012 NHAEA member in order to qualify and may up to 3 student applications.

Member Scholarship: A Member Scholarship of **\$500** is available to help defray the cost of class/workshop and/or materials for that class or to enrich student learning in their classroom. The scholarship winner will be required to turn in receipts/proof of attendance in order to receive their scholarship reimbursement *after* the event. Currently there is **one** Member Scholarship available. The art educator ***MUST*** be a current 2011-2012 NHAEA member in order to qualify!

Please note the following:

In compliance with non-profit tax laws, once you are approved for a scholarship, you will need to provide receipts, proof of attendance and any other related documentation along with the Request for Scholarship Payment Form before scholarship reimbursement can be released to the recipient.
